Dear resident,

In November 2020 we introduced a School Street road closure at school drop off and pick up to create a safe space for children to get to school. The temporary closure aims to help reduce road danger on the road, improve air quality and increase active travel to school.

Since the School Street was introduced, we have been monitoring the situation and listening to your feedback. We are now writing to update you about a small number of changes.

What happens next?

The scheme has been operating under a 'Temporary Traffic Order' since it was introduced. An 'Experimental Traffic Order' covering the scheme is now coming into effect on 14th June 2021 and the times of the School Street are now reducing:

The Henry Cavendish School Street will now operate between 8.15-9.15am and 2.45-3.45pm Monday to Friday.

While the times are changing, this will not affect your access to the road. Residents within the closure zone and Blue Badge holders who require access are still able to enter the School Street at all times. There remains no impediment to Emergency vehicles.
