STOPPING UP ORDER

The London Borough of Lambeth (Stopping-Up of Highways) (Leake Street) Order 2024

Made 17th April 2024

The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990(a), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Lambeth (Stopping-Up of Highways) (Leake Street) Order 2024 and shall come into force on the date on which notice that the Order has been made is first published in accordance with section 252(10) of the Act.

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires:-

“**Council**” means the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth;

“**deposited plan**” means the drawing numbered M000351-3-SK-040, revision E, Project title: Elizabeth House and Drawing title: Leake Street Stopping Up Plan, which is deposited at the offices of the Lambeth Council’s Parking and Enforcement Group (Resident’s Services), 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG;

“**developer**” means SIXTYFIVEHOUSE S.A.R.L

“**planning application**” and “**planning permission**” means planning application 19/01477/EIAFUL and the planning permission granted by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government under Part III of the Act, on 18th February 2021; and

“**statutory undertaker**” has the same meaning as in section 262 of the Act.

3. The Council authorises the stopping-up of the areas of highway in the London Borough of Lambeth shown hatched on the deposited plan and described in the Schedule to this Order, to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission.

4. Any statutory undertaker having apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across the areas of highway authorised to be stopped-up pursuant to this Order, shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus after those areas of highway are stopped-up as they had immediately beforehand.

SCHEDULE

Description of highway to be stopped-up

All that area of the highway of Leake Street in the London Borough of Lambeth which is within the area shown hatched on the deposited plan and is bounded on the north-eastern edge of the highway as extends from a point 7 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of York Road to a point 21 metres south-east of that kerb-line and which has a width of 3.3 metres at its widest point, tapering to a width of 0.10 metres at its narrowest point.
